E1	Please provide an update on your targeting plan including challenges, successes, etc.	<p>NCHAF has committed to targeting vulnerable applicants who fall below the 100% Area Median Income or U.S. Median Income, whichever is greater. Out of the 2057 applicants served, as of the time of this report, 2012 (98%) of these applicants are within this standard.</p> <p>NCHAF prioritized counties (42) and census tracts (237) identified in the program Needs Assessment as North Carolina's most economically distressed and socially disadvantaged homeowners. The Program has received applications from 41 of the 42 prioritized counties, totaling 5,021 applications during this reporting period.</p> <p>To further pinpoint vulnerable communities, our team also focused outreach solicitation in racially concentrated areas of poverty to equitably increase accessibility to those most affected. Over a period of two months, 265 active local organizations were contacted in all 237 census tracts to raise program awareness and solicit their support in increasing program footprint in target communities by accepting printed NCHAF materials. To date, the following materials have been placed with partner organizations across the State: 115 posters, 2,750 rack cards, 475 door hangers, and 2,092 fliers. These locations included social services agencies, community action agencies, community centers, public libraries, houses of worship and faith-based entities, non-profits, and other high-foot traffic locations in targeted communities.</p> <p>Over a period of nine weeks, 23 outreach events were scheduled across 23 of the 42 prioritized counties. The program completed applications on-site and reached 240 constituents and 80 local partners as we traversed these counties. By invitation, the program also participated in three community fairs that allowed us to distribute materials and engage with an additional 688 constituents.</p> <p>Additionally, the program has conducted multiple webinars for housing counselors and legal aid providers to ensure their familiarity with the program and to address any questions they had. As of the date of this report, more than 1,500 NCHAF applicants were referred to the program through a housing counselor and more than 350 were referred through Legal Aid.</p>

USDA is an executed servicer with the NCHAF Program.</p> <p>NCHAF & NCHFA staff have attended and participated in calls hosted by the Housing Policy Council, which are regularly attended by representatives from FHA, VA, USDA, Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac.</p> <p>ServiSolutions is a State Agency that holds mortgage portfolios and are an executed servicer with the NCHAF Program.</p>

Yes	<p>The NCHAF program has coordinated with 150 servicers and has received signed and executed Collaboration Agreements with all 150 to promote a standardized working relationship. An agency-to-Servicer agreement facilitates standard practices and boundaries which allows the program to work with Servicers that have a high volume of borrowers who apply to the program.</p> <p>Additionally, NCHAF has been in constant contact with Servicers for onboarding to the CDF process and use of CDF Transmissions to validate debt. Out of the full population of current servicers (150), 126 (84%) have already been credentialed to participate in CDF transmissions.
